- We need to sell 11 more tickets to sell out the Medium event on April 2nd.
- It was decided that we will not serve hot breakfast for the Senior breakfast. There will be options for gluten free and peanut free items. We will try to get donations from Wawa or Halo Farms for beverages.
- 223 tickets were sold for Tricky Tray. The profit made was \$11,059.11.
- Invites for the Senior Supper will go out around the second week in April. Samples of invitations were discussed.
- A slideshow of senior memories will be ongoing during this event.
- Underclassmen will need to help at this event so that senior parents can be with their children. We will need volunteers for the sign in table, selling of yard signs, and possible 50/50 tickets.
- The price of tickets was discussed and will be \$40 for students and guests.

- We will plan for 350 seniors at the breakfast which will begin at 8 am.
